4/yr.

The journal of the International Association for Energy Economics, this is a scholarly publication covering the economic and social/political aspects of energy. Generally this means electric power, but there is some attention to oil, natural gas, and coal. Representative topics include long-run evolution of energy prices, reducing atmospheric carbon emissions through energy technology substitution, and integrated models of oil production.

ENVIRONMENT

Monthly
(Jan.-Feb.; July-Aug Bi-monthly)

This journal of the Helen Dwight Reid Educational Foundation discusses the subject of pollution on land, in the air, and in the water, primarily in the United States although the "Spectrum" column frequently report articles of interest from overseas. The articles are technical in nature and heavily foot-noted. . PQ, RG.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

Quarterly

This well-established and comprehensive magazine includes articles on biodiversity, species losses and introductions, industry, pollution, and habitat degradation, terrestrial ecosystems and carrying capacity, the dynamics of population and ecosystems, atmospheric and oceanic processes, international environmental law, coastal zone management, environmental economics, and many other topics. they are virtually reviews of the relevant literature.

As such it includes essays on political, administrative, and economic public policy issues at the national and international level. ANNALS OF THE AMERICAN ACADEMY OF POLITICAL AND SOCIAL SCIENCE

Bi-monthly

Looks at health care, social care, rehabilitation, the lives of older people and the changing social roles. Each issue focuses on a single topic. PAIS, PQ, RG.

Each issue is comprised of a dozen articles, thoroughly referenced and written by medical experts, many in the U.S. Department of Health Policy and Management. Topics range from "Reducing Tests on the Road" and "Workers' compensation Recipients with Carpal Tunnel Syndrome" to "The Loss of Independence in Activities of Daily Living."
